Detective Agent Lab

While cooking together as a team, participants will build their social competencies by using perspective taking, flexible thinking, and collaboration. Imagination Stations

Attention all early learners! Let your imaginations run wild through pretend play, building projects, exciting literature and exploration. Take a trip to the moon, build your own restaurant, visit your classroom and go camping at your favorite park! Core Social Thinking

concepts will include practice around: group plan, body in the group, brain in the group, flexible thinking, and shared imagination.

We-Lab
